Key Steps

1. Log into TheTestMart

Sign in to your TestMart account to access the library page.

2. **Identify Tests**


- Use the search bar or press Command + F to find the tests you want to include in your test plan.
- Select the desired tests by clicking the circle next to each test until a check mark appears.

3. Create a New Test Plan

- o Click on the button to add the selected tests to a test plan.
- Choose "Create New" when prompted to select an existing plan or create a new one.

4. Name Your Test Plan

- o Enter a descriptive name for the new test plan (e.g., "Demo Test Plan").
- Click "Create Plan" to finalize.



5. Configure the Test Plan

- o Select the appropriate variable set from the drop-down menu.
- o If applicable, choose the FinOps version for the test plan.

6. Review Added Tests


- o Click on the newly created test plan to view the tests included.

- o Click "Add Header" and rename it by double-clicking on the header title.

8. Add Delays (Optional)

- o If necessary, add a delay between tests (e.g., for batch jobs).
- Specify the duration of the delay.



9. Rename Test Plan (If Needed)

- o Access the ellipses options and select "Rename Test Plan."
- o Enter the new name and confirm the change.

10. Remove Items (If Needed)

To remove headers, tests, or delays, click the "Delete" option or red Garbage
Icon next to the item.

- Be cautious when renaming or deleting test plans, as these actions can affect ongoing projects.
- Always confirm any changes or deletions to test plans before editing or deleting.
